## **TRANSPORTATION**

We provide bikes for you to travel in the area for free. Local Chili Line bus can be used during the week. You are responsible for transportation to and from Taos, New Mexico. If you want us to pick up in Santa Fe or Albuquerque please contact us with the date, time and location you wish us to meet you. Airplanes and trains arrive at Santa Fe or Albuquerque. Greyhound comes to Albuquerque.  
Please donate \$40 for each trip.

## **HOUSING**

To live on the land in our tipi, bus or your own tent we ask a contribution of \$25 per week to cover cost of the toilet, propane, non-recovered food, electricity and other expenses. There is a limit of 12 people living on the land at one time. You can rent a home or house sit in the area and beautiful free camping is possible in the National Forests about ten miles from the land. You can also get a bed or room at the Snow Mansion in Arroyo Seco also about ten miles from the land. Everyone is expected to help maintain the land, kitchen and toilet.
